INSTRUCTION FOR COMPLETING THE TRAFFIC CALMING REQUEST FORM

- On question #1 provide all your contact information.
- On question #2 provide the street segment, where you are requesting traffic calming (example: Broadway Avenue between A Street and B Street).
- On question #3 provide a description of the traffic issues you are concerned about (attach additional sheets or maps if necessary).
- After completing question #3, submit your application to the City. Submit in person, send it by mail, or attach it to an email. See contact information below.
- After submitting your request form, City staff will review and contact you to provide more information about the required petition step.
