

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS #1

CIP NO. 20006 YOSEMITE AVE PROJECT

Q.1.1. The supplemental conditions say there will be no time extensions due to rain. If the ground is too wet to work following a rain event, will that be considered a non-working day?

A.1.1. Please refer to section 00800 supplementary general conditions, 10 weather day allowance is included in part of the special provisions. This allowance includes both weather days due to inclement weather conditions and the conditions resulting from weather in accordance with Paragraph 00700, Weather Delays.

Q.1.2. Section 00820 states the contractor shall obtain and pay for all permits. Please clarify there if there is no charge for an encroachment permit.

A.1.2. City will issue encroachment permits at no cost to the contractor, as long as traffic control plans, are submitted by the contractor to the satisfaction of the City

Q.1.3. Please clarify what equipment the city wants training on under bid item 3.

A.1.3. RRFB beacons, modules and associated electronics.

Q.1.4. Does the city have a staging yard on or near the site the contractor can utilize?

A.1.4. No, the City does not have a staging yard for the project. Contractor will secure, at own expense, areas required for plant sites, storage of equipment or materials, or for other purposes.

Q.1.5. Regarding the above noted Bid, confirming that if any hazardous material is discovered, it will be dealt with by the City or there will be a RFC for the contractor to handle; Basically, hazardous material is outside the scope of work.

A.1.5. Per section 01070, 3.04 A, "No hazardous waste or contamination has been identified at the project sites." The handling, storage, transport, disposal, documentation and reporting related to regulated hazardous waste or contamination encountered at a project site under the authorization of the Director would represent a change in work character and is eligible for a change order in accordance with Section 4-1.05 of the State Standard Specifications.

Q.1.5. Can you please clarify if AB is to be used on this project and what is the depth of the minor concrete. The pay items for minor concrete state AB is to be included and the drawings show 4" concrete/4" AB. Section 73 states do not include AB and all sidewalk/ramps are to be 6" in depth. Please clarify.

A.1.5. Please refer to Addendum #3

Q.1.6. Can you please clarify the quantity of #17 as there does not appear to be 190 CY's of RDX on the project as only 170 TN's of HMA is being placed and AB is not included under the HMA.

A.1.6. The quantity of bid item 17 does not account for the roadway excavation, it accounts for the excavation of AB for curb and gutter, sidewalk/curb ramps, and textured concrete.

Q.1.7. Can you please clarify where and provide details for the textured paving #30? Is it to be the pea gravel as shown on the plans for an exposed aggregate look, is color to be added?

A.1.7. Yes, the texture paving is to be pea gravel as shown in the plans. No color was meant to be added. Please refer to Addendum #3
